

First Quarter Memory Verses

Each quarter, you are responsible for learning weekly memory verses. You will be assessed through a written test at the end of the week. You will also be asked to apply the verse to your life, which you will have the opportunity to write out on your test. This application is worth about 10% of the test grade. Tests will account for 25-50% of your Bible grade (verses use the NIV translation).

August 25-29
